Choosing an Instrument

- Strings: violin, viola, cello, string bass
- Woodwind: flute, oboe, clarinet, alto saxophone
- Brass: trumpet, French horn, trombone, baritone
- Percussion Kit (practice pad and bells)
- Yamaha, Selmer, Gemeinhardt, Jupiter, Conn,
 Eastman, Strobel, & Bellafina are recommended
 beginner brands

Have an Instrument Already?

- If you already have a playable instrument, all you need is to purchase the lesson book and music stand
- If you are buying an instrument PLEASE CONTACT US!
 - Strings especially! They come in various sizes and we don't want you have to buy multiple.

Instrument Specific

- Strings: Rosin, cleaning cloth, <u>shoulder</u>
 <u>rest/sponge</u>
- Flute: Cloth to clean end joints
- Oboe: 2 playable reeds (medium soft)
- Clarinet & Sax: 2 playable reeds (strength 2 ½)
 cork grease, swab
- Saxophones don't forget a neck strap
- Reeds get destroyed!!!!!!

Instrument Specific cont.

- Trumpet: Valve oil & cleaning cloth
- French horn: Rotor oil
- Trombone: Yamaha trombone slide lubricant, spray bottle & cleaning cloth
- Beware of getting the mouthpiece stuck!
- Percussion Kit (Practice pad and Bells in a rolling case) Put your name on every piece of the kit including sticks and mallets

Woodwind Instruments

- Mouthpieces/Headjoints cleaned and then sanitized with disinfectant
- All woodwind instruments removed of grease and dirt with soft cloth
- Bodies, keys and inner bore sanitized with disinfectant

Brass Instruments

- Mouthpieces degreased, then put through Ultrasonic machine w/Ultrasonic solution then sanitized with disinfectant
- Bodies, Slides, Pistons, Valves disassembled, degreased, put through Ultrasonic machine w/Ultrasonic solution, then sanitized

String Instruments

- · Finished surfaces cleaned to remove rosin build-up, dirt and residue
- Chin rests, pegs and tail pieces are wiped clean with denatured alcohol

Instrument Cases

- Interior Vacuumed to remove dirt, dust and other debris and sprayed with disinfectant
- Exterior Wiped down with all-purpose cleaner
