

**Hatboro-Horsham High School  
Laptop Collection FAQs**

**Will the school collect my laptop?**

Seniors are required to turn in their laptop, stylus, and power cord prior to graduation, see schedule below.

Students in grades 9 -11 have the option to keep their laptops over the summer or to turn it in at the end of the school year. Students who opt to turn in their laptop, stylus, and power cord must do so during the schedule listed below.

**What is being returned?**

Student must return the following items:

- Laptop
- Stylus
- Powercord/charger

Cost to replace above items:

- Laptop - \$892.00 +shipping fees (\*\*quote as of Dec. 2017)
- Stylus - \$34.00
- Powercord/charger - \$42.00

**Do I need to remove the items I stuck on my laptop? (Stickers were not allowed!!!!)**

Students are responsible for removing items stuck on the computer before collection.

**I'm a senior and I want my diploma! What do I need to do with my laptop to make sure that happens?**

Your laptop must be collected by the school and all fines must be paid before you are allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony to receive your diploma.

**May I purchase my school laptop after I graduate?**

No. The laptops are part of a 4-year lease cycle and returned laptops will be reimaged and assigned to new students. Please check your post-secondary school for specifications for a laptop at their school before purchasing a new one.

**I'll be graduating, but there is school work on my laptop that I want to take with me. What do I do?**

Seniors: If you would like to save your school work, you should save it to a flash drive. If you need assistance, please go to the Help Desk. Your school work must be saved to your OneDrive for the Help Desk to copy your files. The school cannot copy music, video, or game files!

**Students currently in grades 9 – 11 - Do I need to turn in my laptop?**

In an effort to meet the needs of the many students who participate in online classes, summer school, credit recovery, and summer AP/Pre-AP courses, HHHS allows students currently in grades **9-11** to keep their laptops over the summer.

**What if I do not want to keep my laptop over the summer?**

Students whose families do not wish to accept the responsibility of having the laptop over the summer have the option of turning in the device at the end of the school year. The devices must be turned in during the hours provide on the calendar. All items must be included with the device (laptop, stylus, and power cord). Students will receive a receipt stating what has been returned.

**Will I get my same laptop back next year? When can I pick up my laptop?**

Rising seniors, juniors, and sophomores: If you choose to turn in your laptop, you will be given the same laptop next year during the deployment window or during the first week of school.

**Do I have to pay the tech fee again for the next school year?**

Yes. The tech fee is a yearly fee which covers any accidental damage that may occur to your laptop. Information regarding the technology fee, including the date payment is required, can be found on the High School website.
