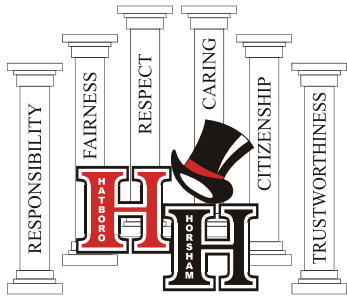


## Hatboro-Horsham School District— Office of Special Services/ Special Education

## How can Medical Assistance benefit my child?

- Medical Assistance (MA) may supplement existing primary health care coverage
- MA may provide coverage for programs and services that are not funded or fully funded by other insurance programs and MA may provide services that are only available through the MA program.
- Services may include: assistance with co-pays, wrap-around services, diapers for children over 3 years, nutrition supplements with prescription, and programs for pregnant and parenting teens.
- School based ACCESS programs allow for school districts to bill Medicaid for medical services delivered to your child. Reimbursed funds are then used to directly support special education programming within the district. Your participation in the school based ACCESS program does not impact your child's benefits and/or participation in outside programs and services.

## Is my child Eligible for Medical Assistance?

If you are the parent or guardian of a student with an IEP who is under the age of 21 and has a learning, speech, physical, or mental health disability **you are eligible to apply for medical assistance for that child regardless of parental income.** All parents are encouraged to apply.

Some guidelines apply:

- A child can qualify for Medical Assistance even if he/she has other health insurance.
- The income/assets of the parents/guardians does not count in determining eligibility if the child's condition meets certain disability standards. Parent/ guardian income still must be verified.

## I have questions, who do I contact in Hatboro-Horsham School District for support?

The district employs an ACCESS Coordinator to assist parents with the Medical Assistance application process. Available supports include:

- Provision of Application Forms and review of application process
