Delegation of Responsibility</p> <p>SC 1303.1-A</p> <p>SC 1303.1-A</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Board directs that the complaints of bullying shall be investigated promptly, and corrective action shall be taken when allegations are verified. Confidentiality of all parties shall be maintained, consistent with the District’s legal and investigative obligations. No reprisals or retaliation shall occur as a result of good faith reports of bullying. <p>Each student shall be responsible to respect the rights of others and to ensure an atmosphere free from bullying.</p> <p><u>The Superintendent or his/her designee shall:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop administrative guidelines to implement this policy. • Shall ensure that this policy and administrative guidelines are reviewed annually with students, staff and adult volunteers. • In cooperation with other appropriate administrators, shall review this policy every three (3) years and recommend necessary revisions to the Board. <p><u>The District administration shall annually provide the following information with the Safe School Report:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Board’s Bullying Policy. • Report of bullying incidents. • Information on the development and implementation of any bullying prevention, intervention, or educational programs.

The policy shall be posted in a prominent location within each school building and on the district web-site, if available.</p> <p><u>Education</u></p> <p>The district may develop and implement bullying prevention and intervention programs. Such programs shall provide district staff and students with appropriate training for effectively responding to, intervening in, and reporting incidents of bullying.</p>

<p>SC 1303.1-A Pol. 218, 233</p>	<p><u>Consequences For Violations</u></p> <p>A student who violates this policy shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary action consistent with the Code of Student Conduct, which may include:</p> <p>Counseling within the school.</p> <p>Parental conference.</p> <p>Loss of school privileges.</p> <p>Transfer to another school building, classroom or school bus.</p> <p>Exclusion from school-sponsored activities.</p> <p>Detention.</p> <p>Suspension.</p> <p>Expulsion.</p> <p>Counseling/Therapy outside of school.</p> <p>Referral to law enforcement officials.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
