GRADES- Each assignment will be given a point value. That point value will depend on the nature of the activity.

It will be the responsibility of the student to keep all returned, graded assignments in his/her binder for frequent parent review.

Project/assignments handed in late will be graded accordingly.

Homework credit will be earned based on the degree of completion, timeliness, and effort.

HOMEWORK – We believe that homework is a valuable tool to helping students achieve the most out of school. Homework will be assigned to reinforce skills/concepts taught in class, prepare for upcoming tests/quizzes, and to enhance independent learning. Most homework will be reviewed in class, corrected by students, and checked for completion. Some assignments will be collected and graded.

MAKE-UP WORK – It is the student's responsibility to secure the work he/she missed due to any absence from class, whether it be in school or out of school. If a student is absent for more than two days, we suggest that work be picked up for the student to complete at home. Please contact the KV Guidance Office by 9:00 AM at 215-420-5075. Books/assignments will be available in main entrance vestibule between 3:15 PM and 6:00 PM. Any long term assignments that were assigned prior to the date of the absence will be due the day the student returns.

RESPONSIBILITY – Students are expected to come to class prepared with the assigned materials for each class. Students will need to replenish supplies throughout the year.

AGENDA BOOK – Students are expected to use their Keith Valley Agenda Book daily. There is ample room to organize homework and plan for long-term projects.

STUDENT/PARENT HANDBOOK – Please become familiar with the handbook which can be found on the Keith Valley Middle School website.

SUPPLIES – Please have supplies available by Thursday, September 17. Teachers will be taking time that day to organize materials.
