

8th Grade Expectations

General Expectations

- We expect that students' behavior will always be appropriate as outlined in the Student/Parents' Handbook.
- Students are expected to be on time for their classes. Students who are consistently late to class may face team and/or administrative consequences (five tardies = after school detention).
- Students are encouraged to visit their lockers and/or bathroom during passing time. If necessary, students will need to sign out during class on a limited basis.

Homeroom

- Students should be in their assigned seats during homeroom and silently listening during announcements.
- Homework should not be done during homeroom.
- All passes must be acquired before 8:00 or after the announcements.

Homework

- In most cases homework is given on a daily basis.
- Credit will be awarded based on degree of completion and/or accuracy at the discretion of the teacher.
- If homework is not brought to class, credit will not be given. Extreme circumstances will be handled at the teacher's discretion.

Projects

- Projects are due on the date established by the teacher.
- A project handed in one day late may result in a 10% reduction of grade, two days late may result in a 50% reduction in grade and no credit may be given on/after the third day.
- Students absent on a due date are expected to turn in the project on the day they return from their absence or the late policy will go into effect.
- In the event of an extended absence from school preceding the due date, the student is responsible for making arrangements with the teacher as to when the project will be due.

Printers

- Please plan and prepare ahead of time by printing work at home, as there are no classroom printers. If necessary, you may print at school before homeroom, during lunch, or after school.

Electronic Devices

- During the school day, cell phones and electronic devices should only be used for educational purposes at the teacher's discretion. Students who do not follow this policy will have their electronic devices turned over to administration.
